In a review of Susan Sterrett's *Wittgenstein Flies A Kite: A Story of Models of Wings and Models of the World* in the March 2009 issue of this journal ('Coincidence and Kite-Flying', pp. 151–154) the reviewer's statement that Wittgenstein was isolated in Norway when he reflected upon reading about the use of a scale model to represent a traffic accident in a Paris courtroom is not correct: the event described occurred in September 1914 while Wittgenstein was serving in the Austrian military. Also, Wittgenstein's isolation in Norway prior to entering the military was not in fact uninterrupted: Wittgenstein spent Christmas of 1913 in Vienna, returned to Norway, and was back in Vienna by July 1914. He did not enter the Austrian Military until August 1914.
